GOTAhams Club Meeting

This month for November we had Grace A. Papay, K8LG, Young Ham of the Year for 2024, with "Beyond The First Contact" a presentation on her personal experiences getting into the hobby, and some ideas on how to attract the younger generation and get them into ham radio.



She also talked about the Youth On The Air camp and how it helps young amateurs to get on the air. The Youth On The Air camp group in the Americas operates a summer camp program made for and managed by young amateurs. The youth campers themselves lead most, if not all, of the camp learning sessions and are involved in the planning, promotion, and operation of the program. They get hands-on learning with satellites, contesting, morse code, kit building, high altitude balloon launches and more.

POTA activation

This month we had our POTA Activation on November 1st, at Pío Pico State Park. Pío de Jesus Pico is one of California's most remarkable historical figures. He was the governor of California in 1832 and again in 1846 before and during the Mexican American War. His adobe home at "El Ranchito" has been completely restored to how it appeared in the 1880s letting visitors experience and celebrate his life and times.

Parks on the Air or (POTA) is an international program for amateur radio operators that encourages them to set up portable radio stations in parks and public lands, promoting outdoor exploration and radio communication. Participants, known as activators, make contacts with other operators, called hunters, and can earn awards based on their activity.



We had four activators at the park: Joe (AK6MB), Ken (KC6WOK), Nilesh (KK6PAH), and John (KI6ZDP).



Tour de Foothills

This year we participated in the tour de foothills providing radio support for the bike rally. The **Tour de Foothills**

is a premier cycling event that brings together riders of all levels for an unforgettable ride through the scenic foothills of Southern California. Whether you're a casual cyclist or a seasoned pro, there's a route for everyone! This year there were around 1,300 cyclists at the event.

GOTAhams helped in the support cars patrolling the 3 different routes (SAG) and monitored the 5 rest stops along the way. We helped injured riders, fixed flat tires, helped coordinate medical emergencies, and returned riders and property to HQ in the SAG cars. And coordinated with the 5 rest stops where cyclists rest themselves, get a bite to eat, and refill their water.



This year our operation went very smoothly. Net Control / HQ was in a better spot away from the noise of the Start / Finish line and the music. It was a fun event and the staff made it known that they appreciate our help with the event. We had two emergencies with riders going to the hospital. One of our operators, Johnathan, was able to pick up the bike and property and deliver it to a friend of one of the injured riders.
